**Trip Includes:**

- Round trip airfare. Leave for Barcelona Saturday, Sept 14. Return on Dec. 8.
- Housing in fully furnished dorms, apartments or homestay.
- A TMB travel pass for unlimited travel on the metro, bus and trams in central Barcelona
- A Barcelona Articket, granting one entry to each of the selected museums and galleries.
- A guided tour of the Sagrada Familia.
- Weekly arranged cultural activities including cooking classes, sporting events, walking tours, hands-on art activities, theater and dance performances, and tapas evenings.
- Tour of City during first week.
- Two group meals; Mid-Semester and End-of-Semester dining.
